# Grade 8 Outcomes

You must choose 5 of the outcomes below for every writing piece you do. For each writing piece, you must have at least one outcome from each list. Each outcome must be used for a minimum of three different writing pieces.

### Writing with Artistry

- 1. Use good/interesting descriptive words to help capture the reader's interest and/or imagination
- 2. Specifically use literary techniques to create mood in your writing
- 3. Use language creatively, experimenting with different word combinations, punctuation, and sentence structure
- 4. Use editing and revision to shape writing according to audience and purpose

### Writing with Clarity

- 1. Explain your personal opinions clearly
- 2. Create an original piece of writing that has a specific purpose and follows the rules for the genre of writing you have chosen
- 3. Writing is organized and easy to follow (i.e. the storyline is logical, the writer does not jump around from topic to topic)
- 4. Use proper spelling, grammar, punctuation, and capitalization with no mistakes

# Writing with Intention

- 1. Consider the ideas of other people and use them to help you create impact in your writing (e.g. research character development, consider an opposing view in your essay)
- 2. Gather information on topics that are important to your writing (i.e. if you short story has an Irish character, you might need to research Irish sayings etc.)
- 3. Experiment with different ways of brainstorming for ideas, characters, names, intro's, conclusions, etc.
- 4. Make a plan or outline for your writing piece (i.e. a plot diagram, timeline, or outline)
